2019 Pool Rules and Regulations

Pool Closures

In accordance with Red Cross Rules and Regulations the pool may close due to inclement weather as follows:

- Temperatures decrease below 68°
- Lightning, Thunder, Snow, Hail, and Severe Rain
- If pool is closed for over **3 hours** it will stay closed for the rest of the day.





ACTIVITY POOL RULES

- Obey Lifeguards at all times
- Parents are ultimately responsible for the safety of their children, Lifeguards are here to enforce rules and regulations of The Pinery Country Club and attend to Aquatic Emergencies
- Please keep behaviors and language to a family friendly environment.
- Children 6 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult 16 year of age or older (Pool Side)
- Children between 12 years of age and 16 years of age must have an adult in the Facility Area (Must Be Checked in by an Adult)
- Non-Swimmer should be within two arms reach of adult at all times. (16 years or older)
- Life Jackets must be **US Coast Guard approved**. Puddle Jumpers and anything inflatable are not permitted.
- NO Running on Pool Deck
- NO Glass on Pool Deck
- NO Rough Housing on Pool Deck
- Diving and Open Swim permitted only in 10ft. area during times that the Dive Board and Slides are not in use
 - o 10a-12p: Deep Area Open Swim (NO FEATURES)
 - o 12p-5p Slide and Diving Board (NO DEEP-WATER OPEN SWIM)
 - o **5p-Close** Deep Area Open Swim (**NO FEATURES**)
- Children under 5ft. Tall will be subject to measurement upon entry of the pool, and if over 48 inches tall will be given a hand stamp for the day that can be used to access both the slide and diving board
- Hourly Safety Break will be called at the 45 of each hour. Adults 18 years of age may use the pool at this time for open swim.
- Proper Swim Attire Required (NO JEANS or COTTON)
- Rope will be up at all times to identify the drop of into the deep water





SLIDE AND DIVING BOARD RULES

Open: 12:00pm - 5:00pm Daily

- Children under 5ft. Tall will be subject to measurement upon entry of the pool, and if over 48 inches tall will be given a hand stamp for the day that can be used to access both the slide and diving board.
- Weight Capacity is 250lbs
- Obey the Lifeguards at all times
- Line will start at base of slide and diving board both features may not be used at the same time.
- One person on each feature per use and user must wait till the person exits the landing before next person uses the feature.

• When Using The Slide:

- NO Life jackets or Sharp objects
- One person at a Time
- Do not stop at slide top or inside the slide runway
- To avoid injury please be sitting down or on your back facing forward
- Make sure landing is clear before use
- Exit Splash Down immediately by using ladder or swimming to the shallow area of the pool.

When Using the Diving Board

- NO Lifejackets
- One person at a Time
- Make sure landing is clear before jumping
- o Jump Straight out and NO Flips
- Exit Splash Down immediately by using ladder or swimming to the shallow area of the pool.

LAP POOL RULES

- Obey the Lifeguards at all times
- NO running on pool deck
- NO Glass
- NO Rough Housing
- No More than 5 people per lane during public swim hours
 - o Swimmers must share lanes with others if Lap Swim is Busy.
 - Recommended: Side Swim (2 or Less)
 - Recommended: Circle Swim (3 or More)
- Children 13 years of age or older are allowed to swim laps for fitness purposes only.
- Children under the age of 12 years of age must have an adult in the area and must be swimming laps constantly. Fitness purpose only.
- During Swim Team all lanes will be closed
 - o Hours of Swim Team: 7:00am 10:00am
- During Programming or Aqua Aerobics, the pool will may be restricted to one lane
- NO Diving unless with permitted swim coach or instructor
- NO hanging on lane lines
- Proper Swim Attire Required (NO JEANS or COTTON)
- Please place all fitness equipment in the proper storage area after each use.







BABY POOL RULES

- NO children over the age of 12 may use The Baby Pool.
- Please close the baby gate whenever you enter/exit.
- Please notify a lifeguard of any accidents.
- Please discourage children from running/rough housing around the pool.
